## LADOIX 1er CRU Le Clou d'Orge

About the appellation?

This appellation is the northernmost of the Côte de Beaune. It produces red and white wines. The white Ladoix appellation covers approximately 20ha, including 6ha in Premier Cru. The parcels classified as premier cru are located on a gentle slope ideally facing south-east.



100% Chardonnay



After manual harvesting, the grapes are destemmed and then pressed. Placed in vats, the alcoholic fermentation begins. The malolactic fermentation takes place in barrels, around 30% of which are new barrels. In our cellars, humidity and temperature are constantly monitored.



Golden in color, our Ladoix Premier Cru offers aromas of acacias, apples, butter and nuts.

On the palate, this wine is firm and lively while presenting a beautiful fullness and a richness balanced by the freshness. It also offers good length.



This wine goes wonderfully with fish, shellfish and seafood. It also goes well with cheeses such as blue cheese, goat cheese and Gruyère.



To be enjoyed between 11°C and 12°C.
